Prize giving and closing ceremony	2.00 PM Prize giving ceremony for sum of two days. Prizewinners of all groups are awarded with trophies of the competition. Additionally prizewinners of 1-3 places in groups M/W21E and MTBO M/W21E are awarded with cash prizes and in other groups – with prizes established by sponsors.

Event Center (EC)

The EC will be established in adventure park Tarzanija.

Tarzanija is located 8 km from Alytus city center, 7 km from the Alytus bus station and about 90 km from Kaunas International Airport (KUN), about 120 km from Vilnius International Airport (VNO) .



Embargoed Areas

The areas marked on the map are embargoed for all orienteering activities, unless specifically permitted by the organizers. The embargoed areas are out of bounds for all potential participants. This means that all potential participants are not allowed to visit these areas with or without a map at all, regardless of whether it is an orienteering activity or a training session, a walk with the dog or a leisurely Sunday stroll.



Classes, Maps and Terrain description

For the Lithuania Cup following classes will be opened: M/W 10, 12, 14, 16, 18, **21E WRE**, 21S (short), 21N (new), 35, 40, 45, 50, 55, 60, 65, 70, 75, 80, Open. MTBO BM/BW 14, 16, E, 40, 50. Participation in Lithuanian Cup is open to all competitors according to their age classes.

M/W21E Oct 14th is **WRE** day. Middle distance M/W21E winning time: 30-35 minutes

GPS will be used in the event for 12 M21E and 8 W21E athletes. The list of athletes to carry GPS will be published in the event center 2h before start and GPS units must be picked up in start area. Live translation will be available at the event center.

The numbers is given only for M/W21E participants at the start area.

Oct 14 th WRE Middle distance	Vidzgiris	1:10.000, H 5m	Moraine terrain is prevailed, carved by erosive ravines. Maximum slopes up to 60 m. height. Terrain is expressive, enhanced with swamps in different height. Grid of pathways is well developed. Visibility and runnability varies from bad to very good.
			
Oct 15 th Middle distance	Radžiūnai	1:10.000, H 2,5m	Most land surface forms are great. A dense network of roads and paths. Mixed forest with coniferous and deciduous trees. Forest dominated by coniferous trees. Visibility from medium to difficult.

The maps are drawn and printed according to the IOF International Specification for Orienteering Maps ISOM 2000.

Start lists for Lithuanian Cup will be determined randomly by Event program.

For WRE participants the start order is determined strictly by the standing of the IOF Middle/Long Distance World Rankings as published on 12 October 2017 (leader starts last).

Important. Oct 15th M/W21E competitors with the best 1st day result will start as the first and the others will start according to their time delay (chasing start/handicap), the forking will be applied.

SPORTident Air+ punching system for the Lithuania Cup will be used. (Punching units can be rented, 1€ per day).

MTBO all groups BM/BW14-50 riders have mandatory to use Air+ card.

Control time 2h.

Distance from event center to start both days ~1-1,9km. All athletes group M/W21E will run with bibs that will be available in start area.

There will be Warm-up map on the way to the start of the first day.

Complaints and protests

Complaints should be handed to the organizer in written form as soon as possible after the incident in question or at latest within 15 minutes of full preliminary results for both classes being posted.

Any protest shall be presented in writing to the jury no later than 15 minutes after the organizer has informed the complainant of the decision about the complaint.
